Of the total Served:

46 had a Stroke/Neurological Conditions 11 had TBI's/NTBI's 07 had Hip Fractures 04 had Orthopedic Conditions 08 had a TSCI/NTSCI 01 had Amputation of Lower Extremity 17 had Misc. Conditions and/or other conditions

69% of persons served were discharged home

70% of persons served that had stroke/neurological conditions were discharged home

72% of persons served that had a TBI/NTBI were discharged home

100% of persons served with fractured hips were discharged home

100% of persons served with orthopedic conditions were discharged home

86% of persons served with TSCI/NTSCI were discharged home

100% of persons served with amputations were discharged home

74% of persons served with other conditions and/or misc. conditions were discharged home

11% of persons served were unplanned acute discharges

95% of persons served reported satisfaction with our rehabilitation program

The average hours of therapy received by persons was 3.0 The average age of persons served was 71 years old
